

Elementary ESL Teacher Certification Program

In order to be considered for admission to The Learning Community's Elementary ESL Teacher Certification Program, applicants must:

- Hold a Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution with an overall cumulative GPA of at least 3.0.
- Have a current Elementary Education Teacher (11201) certificate.
- Be a currently employed educator at an elementary school in a position that allows for at least 45 hours during the duration of our program working with English Learners in grades 1-6 *or* have proof of an agreement with a school administrator and/or classroom teacher whose class you will have access to in order to spend 45 hours working with English Learners in grades 1-6.

Application Checklist:

1. Completed Application, including written essay question(s)
2. A current resume/CV
3. Completed Proof of Employment or Proof of Classroom Agreement
4. Proof of Elementary Education Teacher (11201) certification

5. Official transcripts from any undergraduate institution (and graduate, if applicable) from which the applicant was awarded academic credit and/or a degree. Official transcripts **must be mailed** to:
